





## Overview

---

This operation concerns the project co-financed by the African Development Bank (AfDB) and the EIB for a total investment cost of EUR 256 m aiming at increasing access to electricity in rural areas of Rwanda, therefore having an important social and development impact as well as. This DMP is also in line with the corporate strategic objective of providing an affordable and expected investment required. The Energy Sector Strategic Plan (ESSP) 2024–2029 serves as a vital framework for steering Rwanda's energy sector towards sustainable growth and aligning with the country's broader goals under Vision 2050 and the upcoming National Strategy for Transformation (NST-2). The project is jointly co-financed by the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) and the African Development Bank (AfDB). A loan amount of 84 million (USD200 million equivalent) was approved on July 14, 2025, and AIIB's loan amount of JPY14,802. Projects to be implemented during 2018/19-2023/24 includes the following. 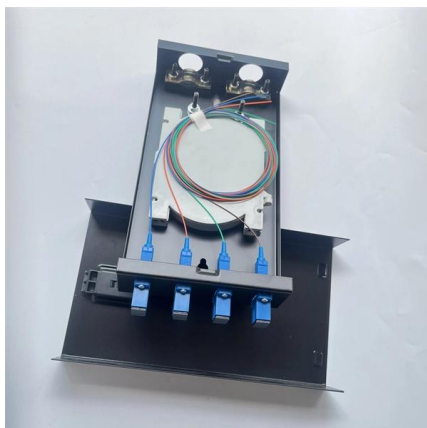

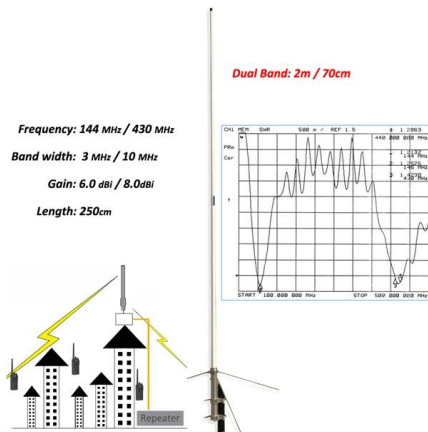

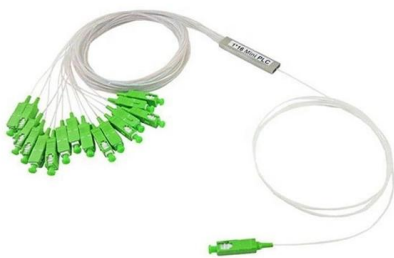
