Overview

Standard cable tray widths typically range from: Tray heights generally range from 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable volume and ventilation requirements. Thickness varies by material and load capacity: Galvanized cable tray thickness must meet ASTM A653 standards for corrosion. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements—width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. Cable trays come in standardized dimensions based on international regulations like NEC (National Electrical Code) and IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission). International projects are most often made in widths of between 50mm and 900mm and depths of between 50mm and 150mm. The majority of the sections have a length of 3 meters, as this is easy to transport and can be compactly. Many different types of wire can be accommodated in cable trays, including High-voltage power lines.
