This cold air is drawn by the computer racks and the hot air is exhausted in the region between back ends of two rows of racks. This region is called hot aisle.

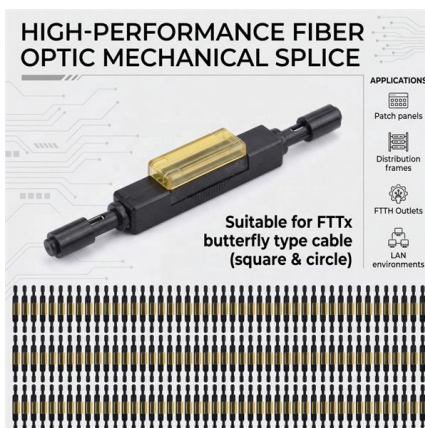

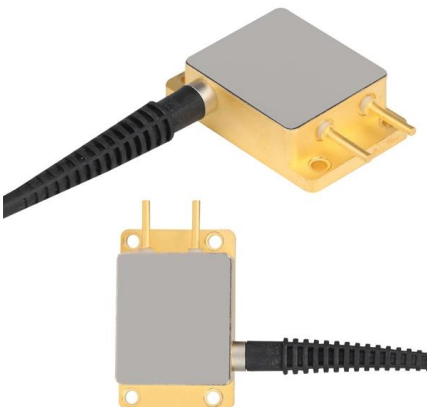
