It was re-opened in January 2012 after major repair works following an accident

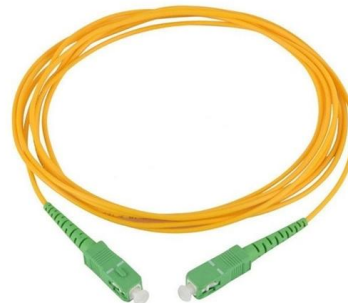
