Whenever I open a .png file saved on my computer (stored locally) with Internet Explorer, instead of displaying the .png image in the browser as it should, a window comes up asking me if I

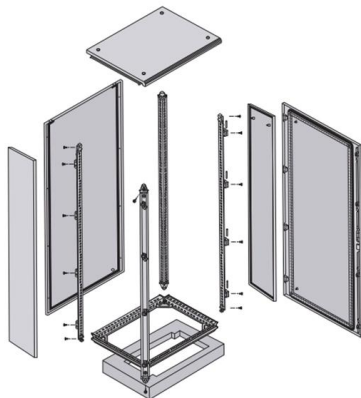
