Overview

For most setups, cables with 12, 24, or 48 cores are common choices, ensuring compatibility with modern equipment and ease of management. The total number of cores for a 1pc fiber patch cable is calculated as the number of branches multiplied by the number of cores per branch (if there are no branches, the number of branches = 1). The number of optical cores in an optical fiber is the total number of equipment interfaces multiplied by 2, plus 10% to 20% of the spare quantity, and if the communication mode of the equipment has serial communication and equipment multiplexing, you can reduce the number of cores. 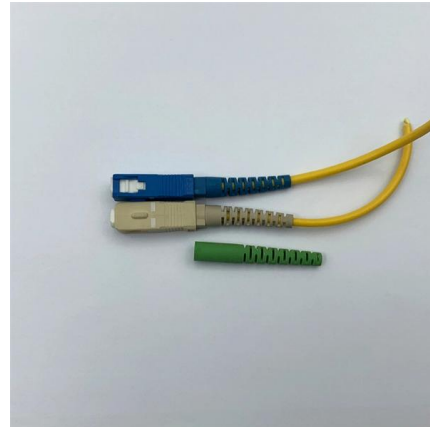

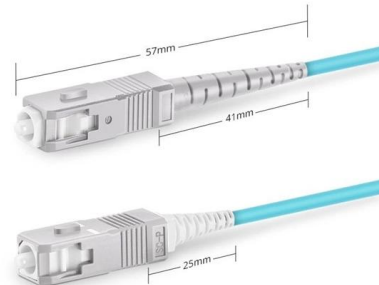
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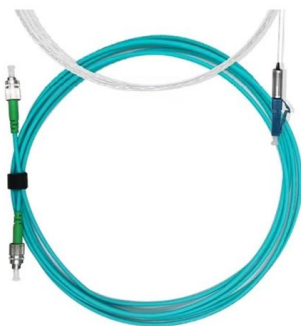
