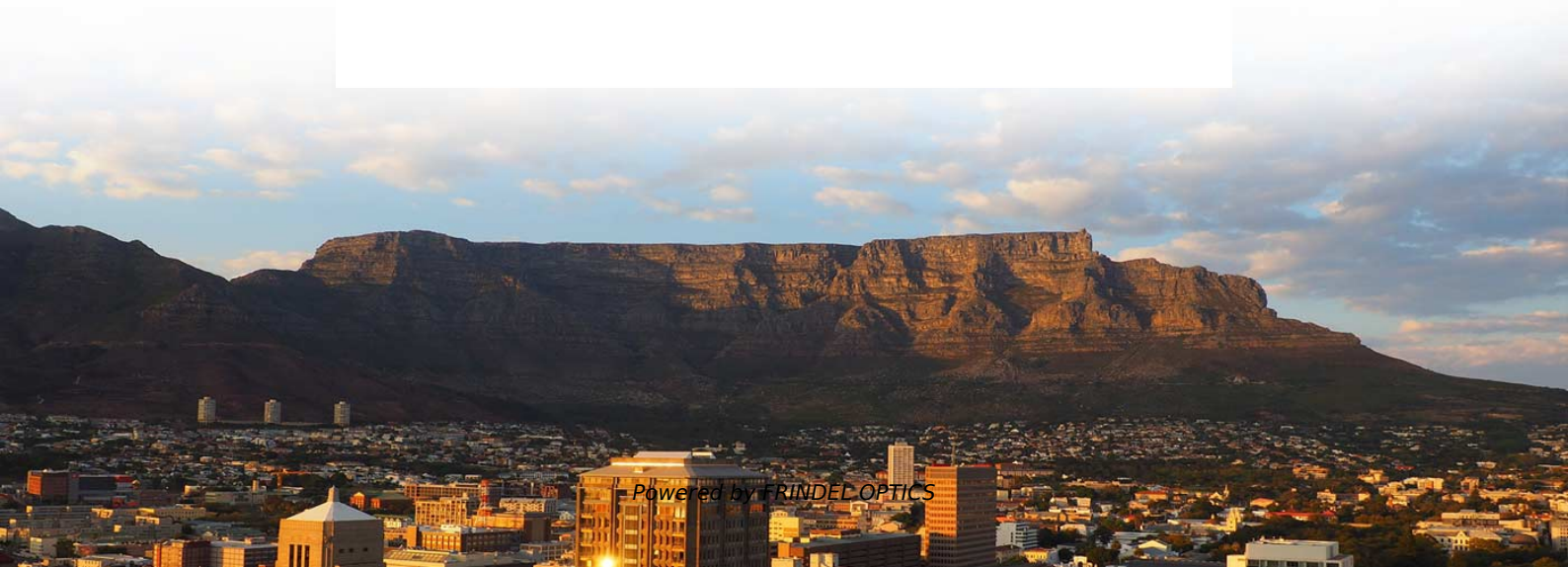


How many square millimeters is the ground wire in the distribution box





Overview

26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The National Electrical Code (NEC) provides clear guidelines for ground wire sizing through Table 250. 122, but understanding how to apply these requirements correctly can make the difference between a safe installation and a costly code violation. The NEC ground wire size chart defines the least instrument grounding conductor size for single and 3-phase systems according to conductor size for ranges such as 14 AWG to 4000 kcmil. $127 \text{ mm} \times 92 (36-n)/39$ The n gauge wire's cross sectional area A_n in kilo-circular mils (kcmil) is equal to 1000 times the square wire diameter d. It ensures safe fault current paths, compliance with NEC codes, and reliable protection for residential, commercial, and industrial installations.
