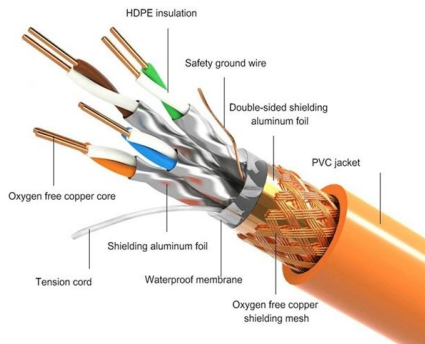
Overview

Cable Management Tray Size: Choose a tray size that will hold the desired amount and length of cable. **Bend Radius:** The tray cable bend radius should be supported to avoid damaging the. Some outdoor cable tray installations may have to span anywhere from 20 to 40-feet to cross roads. The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads. 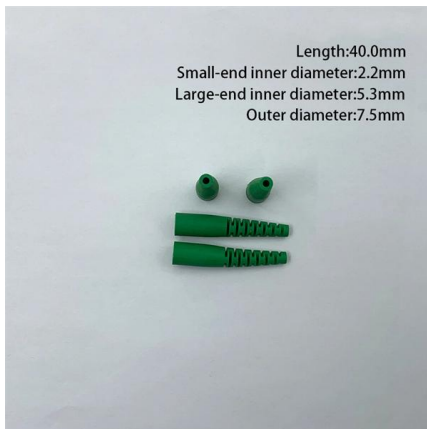

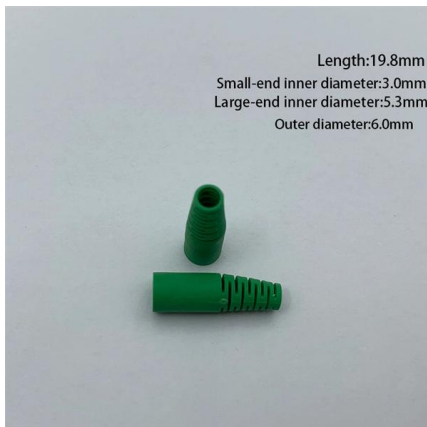
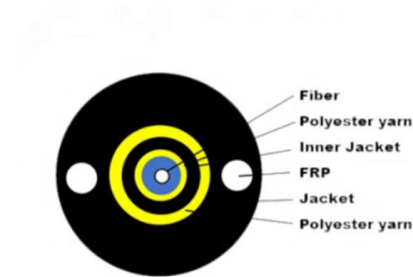

The support span is the distance of cable tray between supports. Your cable tray length must always be longer than or equal to the support span you have selected.

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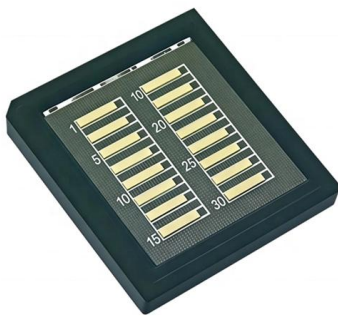

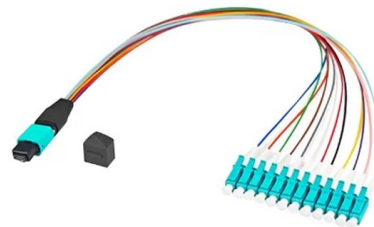

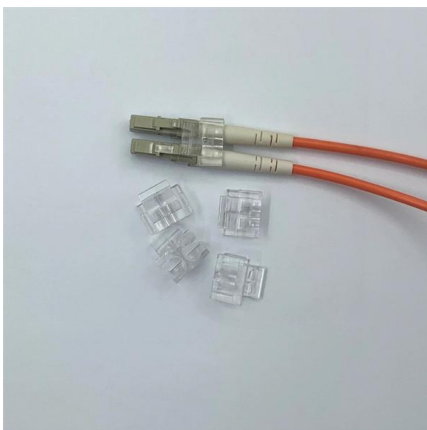
