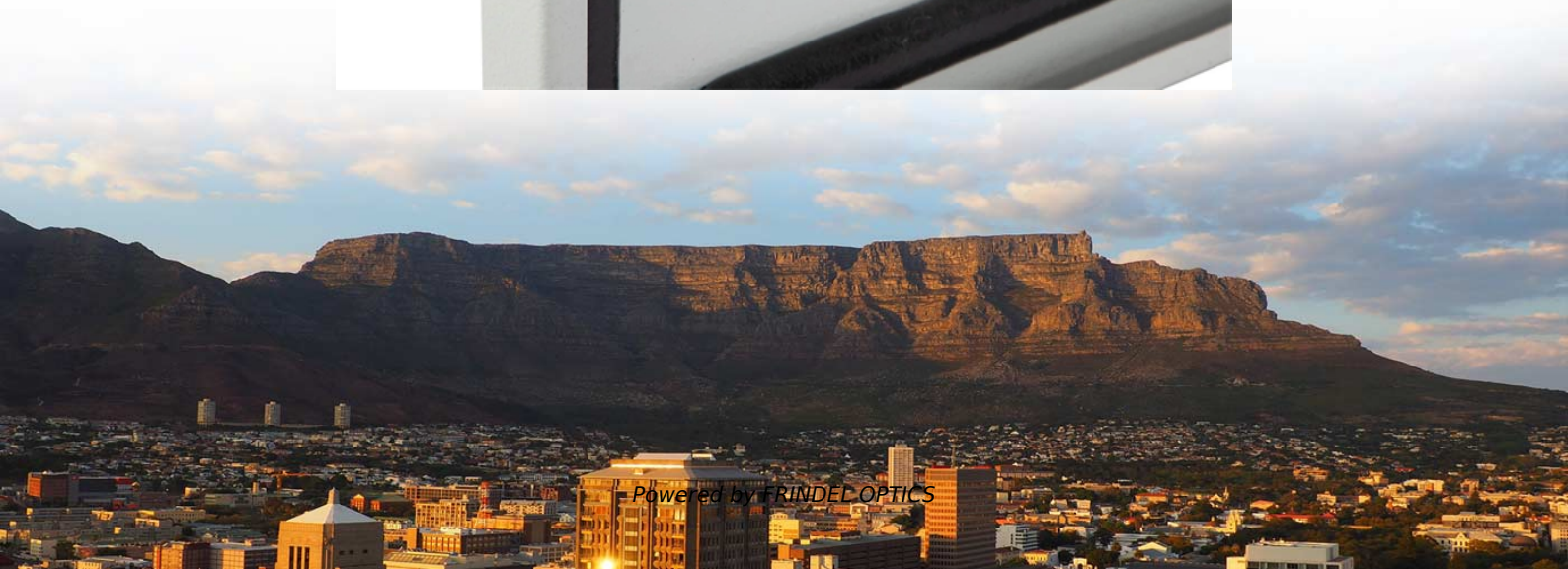


Internet disconnection occurs when multimode fiber optic cable is plugged in





Overview

Physical Damage : Cuts, bends, or contamination in fiber cables or connectors. Fiber optic cables are comprised of multiple optical fibers bundled together, surrounded by a protective layer called the cladding. The cladding ensures the internal light signal is retained within the fiber and prevents loss of signal through absorption or scattering.
