

Mexico customs declaration 1G of packaged optical components





Overview

To declare goods at Mexico customs, travelers must complete a Customs Declaration Form for items exceeding duty-free limits, provide required documents like passports and receipts, and be aware of penalties for non-compliance, which may include substantial fines;. For tax purposes, all Mexican importers must register and be listed with the Official Register of Importers (Padrón de Importadores), maintained by the Secretariat of Finance and Public Credit (Secretaría de Hacienda y Crédito Público or SHCP), which also maintains special sector registries. The decree issued on November 19, 2025, amends several provisions of Mexico's Customs Law, which will come into force on January 1, 2026. This reform raises the standard for regulatory oversight and tightens validation requirements for stakeholders in foreign trade. When it comes to computer equipment, the value added with the rest of the goods should not exceed 4,000 USD or.

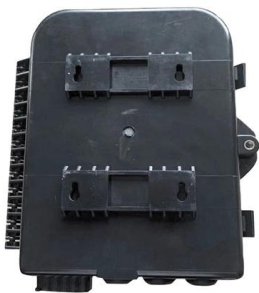

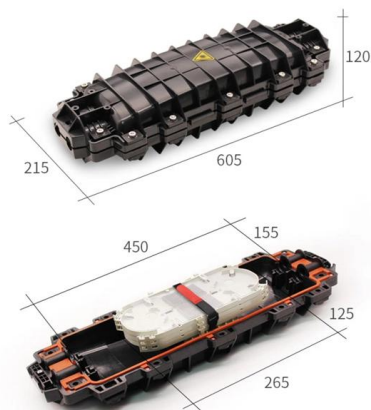

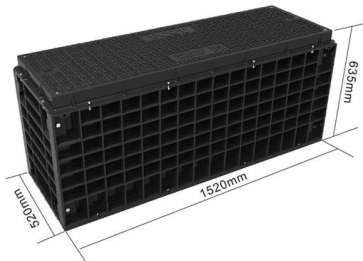
