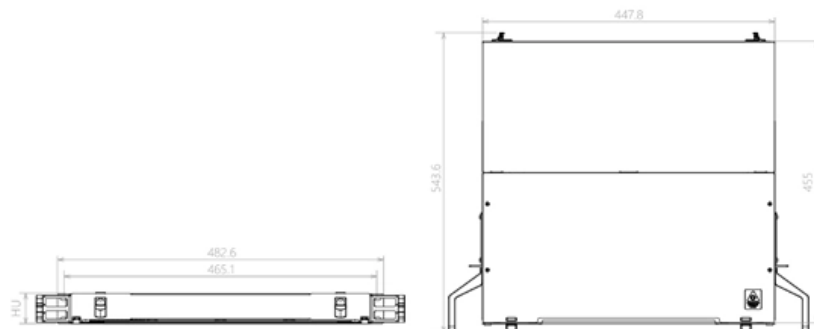


Power pole optical cable

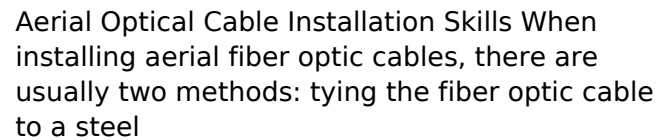


Overview

OPAC (optical power attached cable) is a type of fiber optic cable that is installed by attaching to a host conductor along overhead power lines. One way round this is to install aerial fiber cables close to power lines, such as on mixed use poles which also carry electricity.
