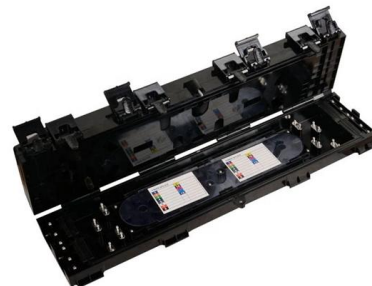

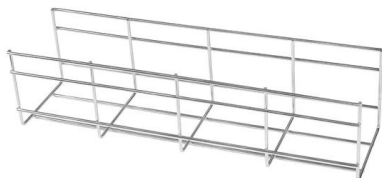
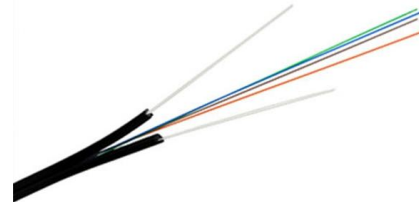

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Melt Blowing

Sudden cooling of the fiber as it emerges from the orifice of the die prevents attenuation of the fiber to a smaller diameter, which can be improved by increasing the temperature of the air used for the drag.

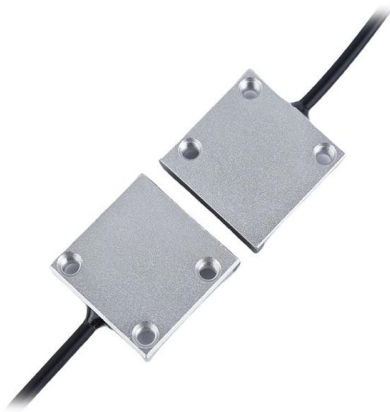

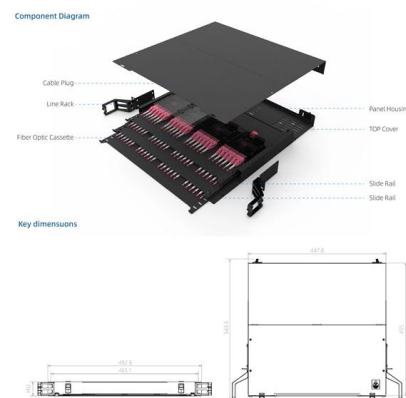

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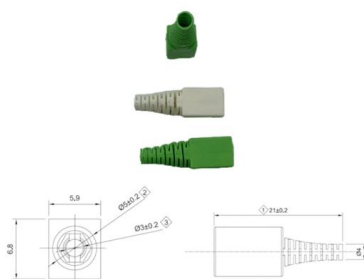
