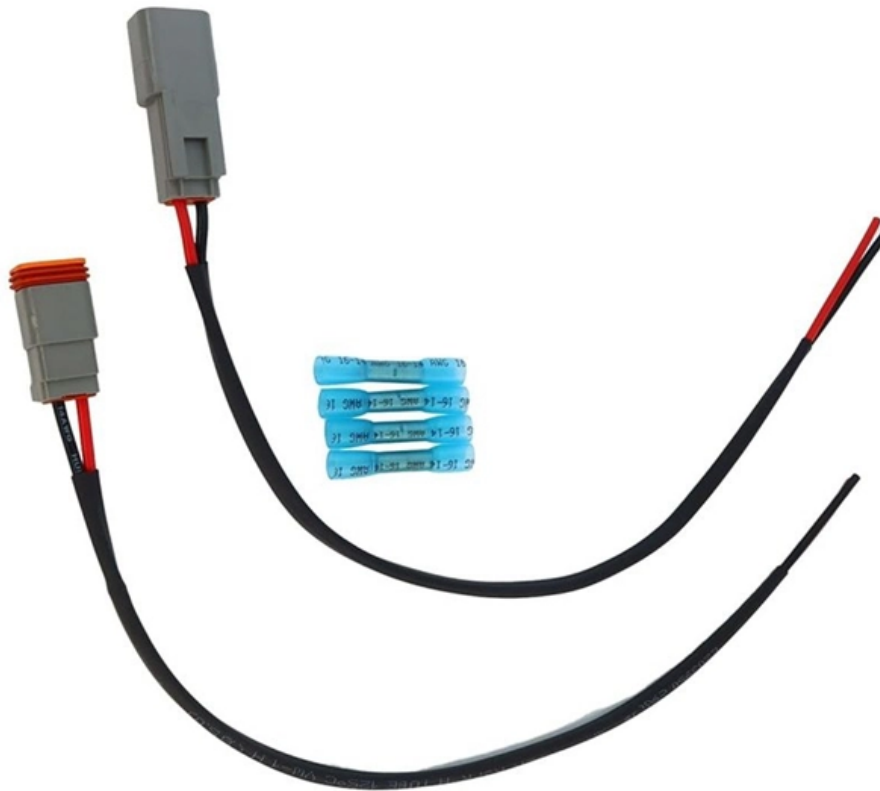


# Spacing of cable tray supports against the wall





## Overview

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The NEC requires that cable trays must be supported by members at an interval specified by the cable tray manufacturer, but not more than 5 feet for horizontal runs to support the weight of the cables and other loads. The safety of your people and the reliability of your electrical system depend on proper cable tray support spacing.
