

Telecommunications fiber optic cable conduit diameter





Overview

Optical cable is usually placed in a 25 to 40 mm inside diameter (ID) sub-duct which is placed into an existing larger diameter communications conduit.

Example: To arrive at a working bend radius for cable installation, multiply 15 times (15 x) the cable outside diameter. The size of conduit you should use depends on the type of fiber optic assembly and the number of cables it will house. 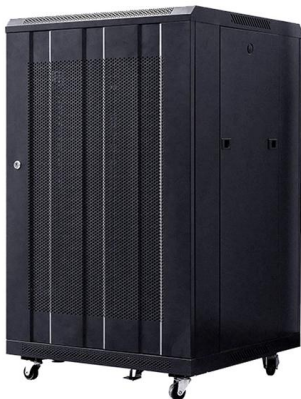

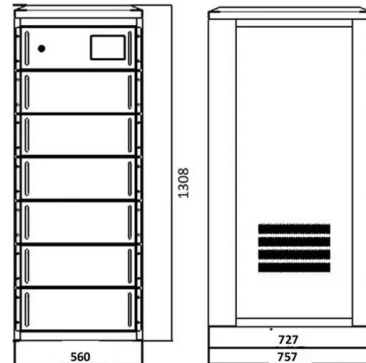

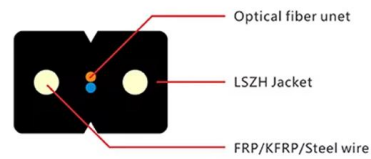
