Common Angles & Formulas: · 30° Bend: Cut Length = 2 × Offset | Travel = 1.
When available, a band saw is usually the most appropriate tool for cutting thin metal products such as cable ladders and trays. 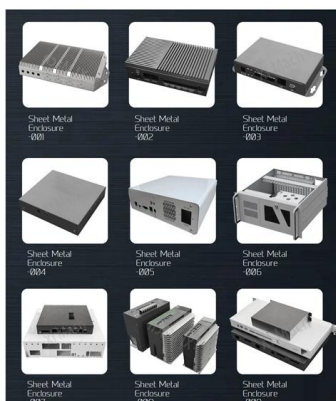

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CUTTING GUIDELINE

Where products have to be cut at irregular distances, we recommend having the open cut end placed inside where possible (I.e. open ends of support inside the starter bracket, open ends for ladders and

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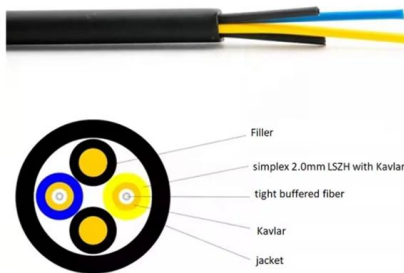
