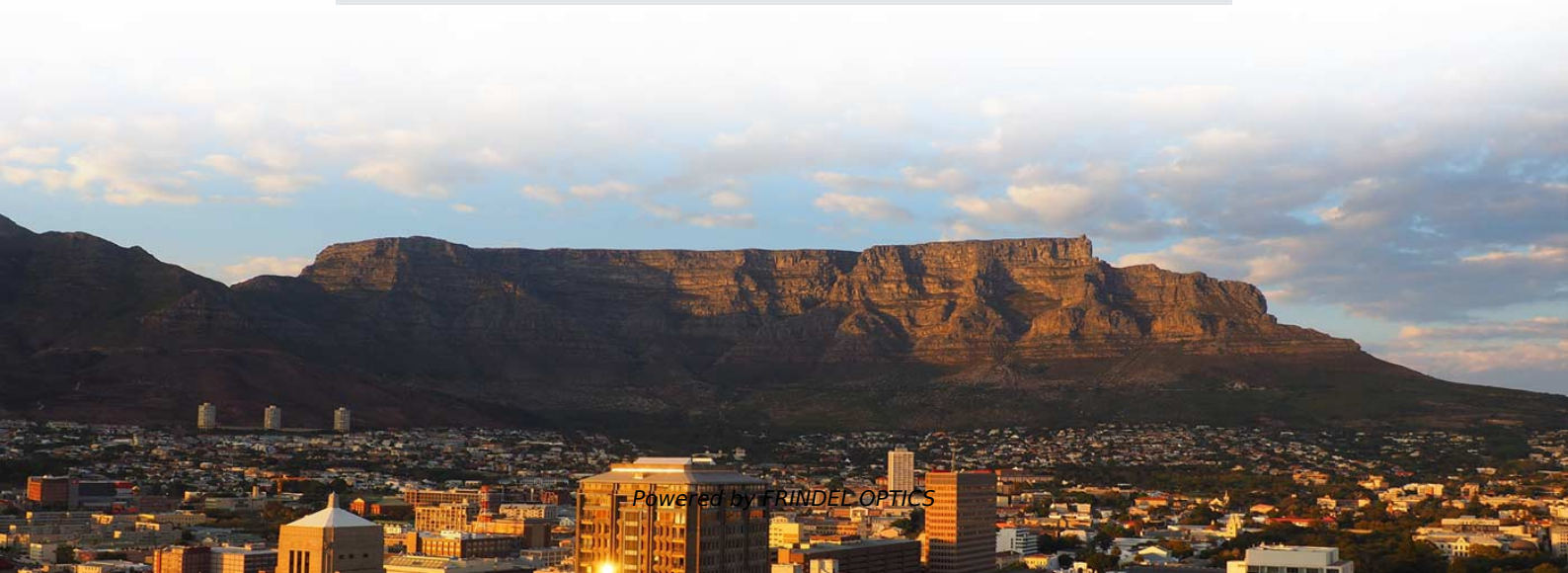

Why do pigtails not count towards box volume capacity

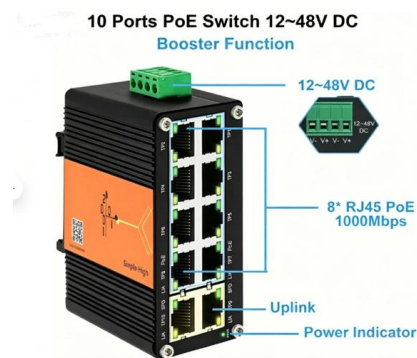
