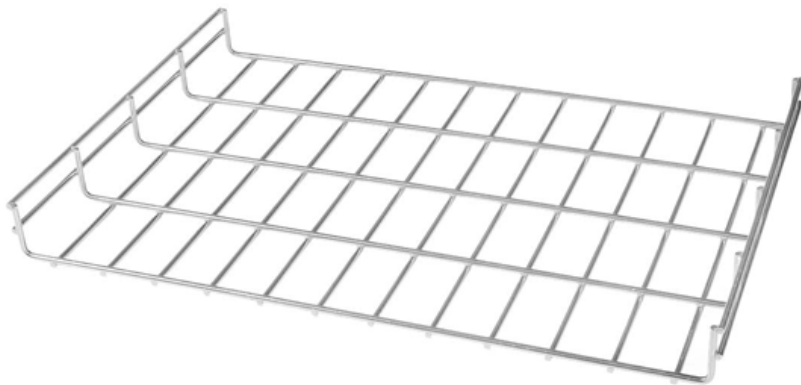


What quota should be applied to cable tray support arms

Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \text{Total Length} \div \text{Support Spacing} + 1$ $20 \div 2 + 1 = 11$ supports In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. 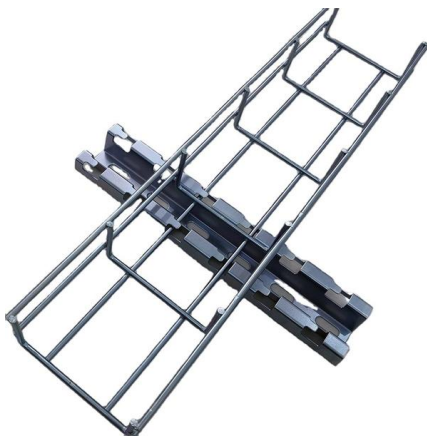

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Chapter 14 Cable Support systems

The least beneficial location for the splice connectors are at the mid point of the span or right over the support. Placing the splice connector in these two places should be avoided, especially on end spans.

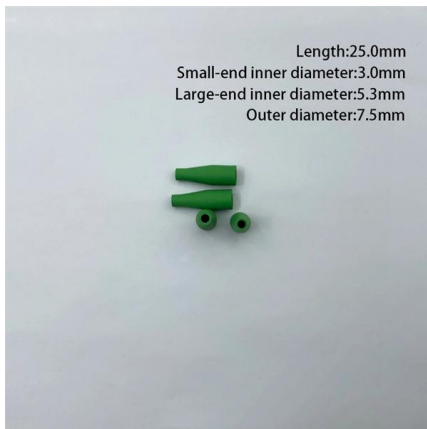
